## 2024 TETRATHLON RULEBOOK

## USPC FESTIVAL

The USPC Festival is a two-in-one event with Championships at the beginning of the week and Education following.

**Championships:** July 15 – 19

**Education:** July 20 – 22

## FESTIVAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

### Ride Specifications

All Tetrathlon Ride phase rounds will include the slip rail and gate for all divisions.

### Championships Eligibility

Members who wish to compete at the USPC Festival Championships must meet the age, certification, and competition eligibility requirements as outlined in the rulebooks and in the 2024 Competitor Eligibility Document, found on the Championships Competition Resources page, <https://www.ponyclub.org/Events/Championships/CompetitorInformation.aspx>.

### Reminders

- Pre-Novice is the lowest level of competition offered at Championships. No competitors will have the option to compete down lower than the Pre-Novice heights and distances.
- If a competitor competes down at their regional rally, they must compete down and incur the penalties associated with competing down at Championships.
- To be eligible for Championships, a competitor may not compete down more than one division.

## Eligibility Exceptions

Competition eligibility exceptions will be handled on a case-by-case basis. There are no exceptions to the age or certification requirements.

The RS **must** submit all competition exception requests using the online system, <https://www.ponyclub.org/Events/Championships/CompetitorInformation.aspx>. Only submissions submitted by the RS will be considered.

## FESTIVAL EDUCATION

USPC Festival Education is open to all USPC members, leaders, and friends. Mounted clinics are offered in various disciplines including: Dressage, Show Jumping, Cross-Country, distance riding, horsemanship and more. Mounted clinics will be available to audit.

Also offered at Festival Education is D-Camp and a large variety of unmounted clinics.
