2026 USPC Festival

The weeklong [USPC Festival](#) is held every other year at the Kentucky Horse Park in Lexington, Ky., and is a blend of USPC Championships and Educational clinics.

Championships

Pony Club is proud to offer Championship competitions in eight competitive disciplines, as well as open competitions in Gymkhana and Trail. The qualification period for 2026 Festival Championships is January 1, 2025–June 22, 2026 (the entry closing date). Entries will open May 1, 2026.

Members who wish to compete at the USPC Festival Championships must meet the age, certification, and competition eligibility requirements as outlined in the rulebooks and in the 2026 Competitor Eligibility Document found on the [Championships Information page](#).

Education

USPC Festival Education is open to all USPC members, leaders, and non-members. Mounted clinics are offered in various disciplines, including: Dressage, Show Jumping, Eventing cross-country, distance riding, horsemanship and more. Mounted clinics will be available to audit.
