## 2025 Tetrathlon Rulebook

The 2025 rulebooks are now available in [Shop Pony Club](#) and on the [USPC website](#). Edits and clarifications are noted in red font. Please note the following changes:

- Article 15 – Safety: The Safety Committee has made updates to headgear and protective safety vests (policies 0810 and 0830).
- Chapter 1 – The penalty for riding down is now 300 penalty points for the first level dropped.
- Article 48 – Clarification to cone locations outside of slip rails and gates.
- Article 55 – The penalty for running down is now 400 points for the first level dropped and 200 points for every additional level dropped.
- Article 60 – Update to running phase optimum times.
- Article 66 – Championships competitors must have a locking case for their pistol.
- Article 72 – The penalty for swimming down is now 400 points for the first level dropped and 200 points for each additional level dropped.
- Article 75 – Updates to swimming phase optimum times.
- Appendix X – New scoring tables for running and swimming.
- NEW: Peacock stirrups are no longer permitted.

### 2026 USPC Festival

The weeklong [USPC Festival](#) is held every other year at the Kentucky Horse Park in Lexington, Ky., and is a blend of USPC Championships and Educational clinics.

### Championships

Pony Club is proud to offer Championship competitions in eight competitive disciplines, as well as open competitions in Gymkhana and Trail. The qualification period for 2026 Festival Championships is January 1, 2025–June 22, 2026 (the entry closing date). Entries will open in spring 2026.

Members who wish to compete at the USPC Festival Championships must meet the age, certification, and competition eligibility requirements as outlined in the rulebooks and in the 2026 Competitor Eligibility Document found on the [Championships Information page](#).

### Education

USPC Festival Education is open to all USPC members, leaders, and non-members. Mounted clinics are offered in various disciplines, including: Dressage, Show Jumping, Eventing cross-country, distance riding, horsemanship and more. Mounted clinics will be available to audit.

A large variety of unmounted clinics and D Camp are also offered at Festival Education.
