


MEMBERSHIP BY AGE

Pony Club teaches **HORSEMANSHIP**, not just riding.

Members learn about horse care, riding, and safety; progress through Pony Club certification levels; and participate in Pony Club team competitions called rallies.

Each level of the program is progressively more challenging, from the beginning D-1 up to the advanced A-level certification.

Pony Club is committed to **SAFETY** for both horse and rider.

Pony Club prepares youth members with skills they need to succeed in life. Our equine educational programs are structured to build confidence and develop personal responsibility.


