Registration Types

All-Access Pass

The All-Access Pass includes four days of leadership training (as eligible based on leadership position) and all Convention activities. Includes access to educational workshops, the Anatomy Room, Horse Management Room, a continental breakfast at the Meeting of the Corporation, a daily buffet lunch (Thursday-Saturday), and Trade Fair. Attendees who register before late registration begins January 2 may purchase tickets for meal functions (Thursday Leadership Evening Event and Saturday Night Banquet).

This registration is geared toward leaders and officers in Pony Club who would like to attend all four days of Convention, including attending the leadership training sessions on Thursday and Friday.

Weekend Registration

A Weekend Pass includes three days of educational workshops, Anatomy Room, and Horse Management Room, a continental breakfast at the Meeting of the Corporation, a daily buffet lunch (Friday-Saturday), and Trade Fair. Attendees who register before late registration begins January 2 may purchase tickets for meal functions (Saturday Night Banquet) and receive commemorative event swag.

This registration is geared toward those who wish to attend educational workshops and activities on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. This registration is also geared toward participating members who may be attending Convention with their parents/guardians who hold leaders or officer roles.

Pony Paddock

Youth under 12 years old may be registered to participate in a chaperoned room of activities and fun. All attendees MUST be potty trained. Pony Paddock visits the Anatomy Room, Horse Management Room, and select workshops. Attendees may also enjoy other aspects of Convention with a parent.

Registration includes Pony Paddock attendance all 4 days of Convention and a Pizza Party Saturday night. Daily lunch is included, although attendees must be checked out by a parent during lunchtime.

Day Passes

Day Passes allow for participation in the event on either Saturday or Sunday. Includes access to equine workshops, the Anatomy Room, Horse Management Room, and the Trade Fair. Does not include ability to attend leadership training, or purchase tickets for additional meal functions.


Registration Process

Navigate to Registration - Members

To access the registration pages/options for the 2026 USPC Convention, individuals with a USPC account will need to be logged into the website to receive correct pricing.

Once logged in, the link to "Convention Registration" is located in the Competitions and Events section on the individual's profile.

Competitions & Events



From the individual's registration page, they will choose from 'Register Self', 'Register Family', or 'Register Others'.



Register Self

Use this option to register yourself for Convention.

Register Family

Use this option to register anyone in your family for Convention. Users flagged as your family member in the USPC database will appear here (If your family member doesn't appear, select "Register Other" to register them).

Register Others

Use this option to register anyone who wishes to attend Convention who is not related to you or otherwise associated with USPC.

*This option is normally used when individuals wish to register a family member, spouse, or friend who is not already in our database or has no other affiliation with USPC.

If you are a current member, parent or leader with Pony Club, please sign in (using the link above). You must be logged in to receive the member prices.





Leadership Positions


The next page will list any Leadership or Committee positions that you either currently hold or will hold in the upcoming year that are on record. If you will be



holding a position in the new year and it is not listed, use the dropdown boxes to select the position you will be holding. This will ensure that you receive all the appropriate registration options. Use the left dropdown to toggle between Leadership and Committee positions, and the right dropdown to pick the specific position. Click "Add Position" to save, and it will appear below the dropdown boxes.

Agenda

The Agenda page is personalized based on your registration type, Leadership and Committee status, and whether it is a regular or late registration.

Activities such as Educational Workshops, the Anatomy Room, Horse Management Room, Research Project Fair, and Trade Fair are open to all and will not be listed as agenda items. Leadership and Committee meetings and meal-ticket events are agenda items and must be selected to attend.

Sign-up for meal events is not available to Late Registrations.

Meal-Ticket Events

Some agenda items require a meal type to be chosen for the attendee and/or their guest.

When the agenda item is added and a meal is selected, a new agenda item will appear that says "(Event Name) – Guest 1" and will require the guest's name and meal choice. After Guest 1 is selected, Guest 2 will appear, and so forth.

After all agenda items have been chosen, you may view the "Review Registration" page. This page will show all contact information, leadership/committee positions, agenda items, and a summary of fees. If all the information on your registration is correct, press the "Submit and Checkout" button in the bottom-right corner of the Registration page to pay immediately, or the "Submit" button to return and pay later.

Alternatively, you may press "Back" to review/change a previous registration page, "Cancel" to leave the registration without saving, or "Save" to save an incomplete registration and return to it later.



Submit

If "Submit" is selected, the registration will be saved but not considered complete until payment is received. Your registration will show a positive balance due. Registration fees (Regular/Late) are based on the time of payment. The submitted registration will appear on the registration page, under "Submitted Registrations". To pay, select "Pay Now", and you will directed to the payment portal.

Submitted Registrations

You may still edit the registrations to add new agenda items. *Please Note: Sign up for meal events is available only through the close date of regular registration.*

If a registration has a box in the "Pay Now" column, then the registration or an added item (if you added an agenda item after paying for the original registration) has not been received by the National Office. The Registration Fee is based on the date/time the Registration payment is submitted.

Submit & Checkout

If selected "Submit & Checkout" is selected, it will direct to the payment portal. The time payment is received will dictate the registration fee (Regular/Late). The registration is now complete.

Add Agenda Items

After the registration is submitted, attendees will have the option to add agenda items. Paid items, like the Saturday Night Banquet, will require a new, separate payment. To add an item, click the "Add Items" button. It will direct back to the agenda items page. If you choose to pay for these items later, your submitted registration will show a positive "balance due". Meal ticket items such as the Saturday Night Banquet must be paid by the Regular Registration deadline, January 5.

Any positive balance on your registration must be paid for your registration to be considered complete.
