If you are flying into the Chicago O'Hare International Airport, the hotel is just 18 miles away. The Lincolnshire Marriott Resort does not provide shuttle services; they recommend booking with [Windy City Limousine](#).

If you are driving to the Lincolnshire Marriott Resort, note that the parking is complimentary to guests.

Once on site, attendees can check into the Lincolnshire Marriott for their sleeping accommodations. Hotel check-in begins at 4:00 p.m. on the day of arrival. Around the corner and to the right of the concierge desk is the Grand Ballroom, where educational workshops will occur over the weekend. After checking in, take a right down the hallway towards the coat room. The Convention Registration Desk is located in the coat room at the end of the hallway in front of the Grand Marquee Pavillion.
