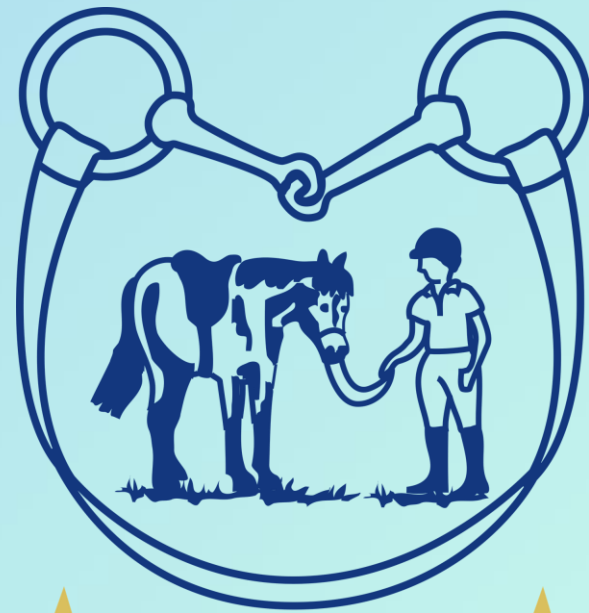

PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM

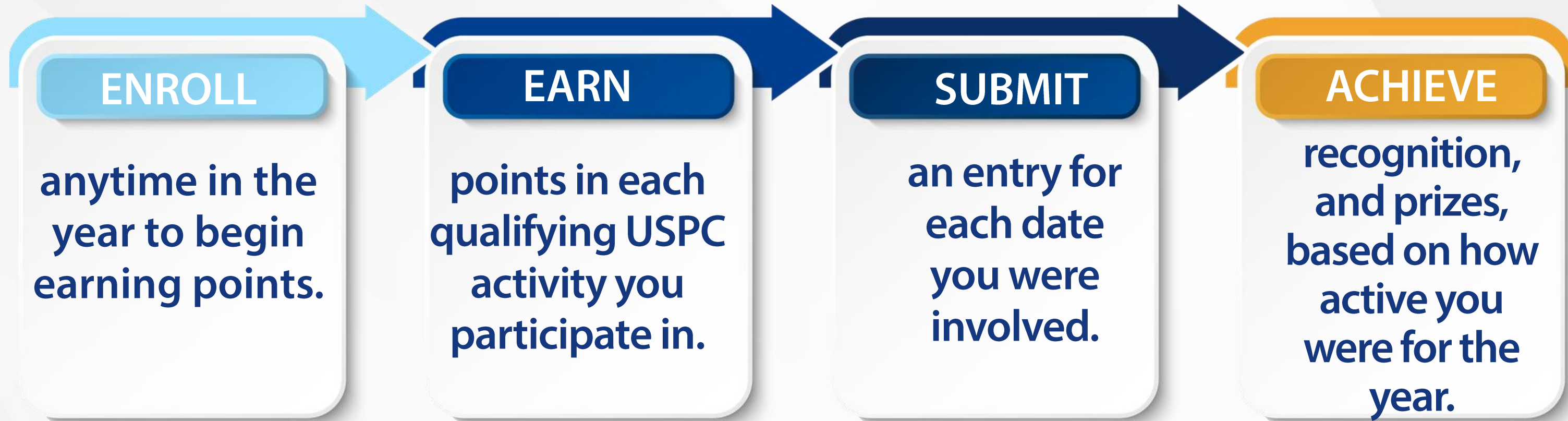

Any active, compliant Participating Member, regardless of age or certification level, can earn points for participating in everyday USPC activities, as well as regional, national, and international events.

It encourages member participation and provides a positive experience to honor “achievement” within USPC.

HOW DOES IT WORK



Members can enroll for a nominal \$30 per year at any point in the year.

AGE DIVISIONS

Members participate within various age divisions and win awards based on national rankings and recognition pins based on an individual's total points.

- 8 and Under
- 9 to 12
- 13 to 15
- 16 to 19
- 20 to 24
- 25 to 29
- 30 to 49
- 50 and Over

AWARDS

Members receive recognition pins at 300 points. Those who place in the Top 10 in their divisions win prizes from LeMieux during the USPC Convention.

HOW TO EARN POINTS

- Points only awarded to those with an “Active Participating Member” status.
- Points are non-transferable between members, parents, and/or leaders.
- Points are ONLY earned from the sign-up date onward. So the EARLIER you sign up, the better.
- Points are claimed by the “activity” (multiple per day allowed).
- Points for “events” cannot be claimed by the day.
- Points are accumulated from January 1–December 31 of each year.
- Points are pulled out of the system on January 1 of the following year.
- Members must contact their club/region if records are missing.
- USPC reserves the right to refuse or deny points.

<i>Achieve "A" Certification</i>	150	<i>Must have certification on record with the National Testing Coordinator.</i>
<i>Participate in International Exchanges</i>	100	<i>Includes: IMGE, IPE, Foxhunting, Quiz, Tetrathlon, Virtual Dressage, Virtual Quiz, and Virtual Show Jumping.</i>
<i>Participate in Festival Education</i>	100	<i>Must have entry on file with the USPC National Office.</i>
<i>Participate in Festival Championships</i>	100	<i>Must have entry on file with the USPC National Office.</i>
<i>Achieve a C-3, B, H-B, or H-A Certification</i>	100	<i>Must have certification on record with the National Testing Coordinator.</i>
<i>Special National Opportunity</i>	75	<i>Includes: Research Project Fair, Prince Philip Cup, USEF Pony Jumper Championships, Upper-Level Member Showcase, and the USHJA Horsemanship Challenge.</i>
<i>Achieve Local Certification</i>	75	<i>Includes: D-1, D-2, D-3, C-1, and C-2 certifications. Must have new certification entered in USPC system.</i>
<i>CHMJ/Co-CHMJ/PCHMJ at Rally or Championships</i>	75	<i>If at Festival Championships, must have record of full-time volunteer staff.</i>
<i>Attend Convention</i>	75	<i>Must be registered through USPC Database</i>

<i>Attend a Multi-Day Region, Center, or Club Camp</i>	40	
<i>Teach a clinic, at a camp, or a lesson</i>	20	
<i>Attend a mounted meeting, clinic, or club/center lesson</i>	15	
<i>Attend an unmounted meeting</i>	10	
<i>Volunteer for 8+ hours with your Region, Club, or Center</i>	10
