**I. POLICY STATEMENT AND PHILOSOPHY:**


The policy of the Board of Governors is that rally competitions in various disciplines be held as a complement to the United States Pony Clubs, Inc. instructional program. Rallies offer members the opportunity to gain experience in the varied disciplines as well as in caring for their mount in a safe and workmanlike manner with minimal assistance. Rally competitions provide members with leadership skills and sportsmanship through team experiences that focus on team achievement.

All USPC rally competitions, including Quiz rallies, are conducted according to the specifications in the USPC discipline rulebooks, and all USPC mounted rally competitions must include the Core Activity of Horse Management per USPC Policy 0150.

**II. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY:**

- A. The RS shall have the responsibility for this policy at the regional level.
- B. The Vice President for Activities shall have oversight of this policy.
