POLICY 6006P PROCEDURES FOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

A. General

- 1. The term "Championship" refers to any final competition that is organized by the USPC National Office.
- 2. Championships are the responsibility of the Activities Director in consultation with the Vice President of Activities (VPA).
- 3. All USPC Championships are conducted according to the USPC discipline rulebooks, annual newsletters and specified competition documentation.
- 4. The Activities Director, in consultation with the VPA, shall submit budgets for approval by the Board of Governors in accordance with Board Policy #7400.
- 5. Staff and officials for Championships must be approved by the Activities Director in consultation with the VPA.
- 6. Chief Horse Management Judges must be chosen from the current published Chief Horse Management Judges list in consultations with the Director and Vice President of Instruction (VPI).
- 7. All mounted Championships shall include Horse Management.

B. Eligibility of Competitors

To be eligible for a Championship, competitors must qualify per the discipline requirements as specified in the USPC discipline rulebooks, annual newsletters, competition documentation, and by the Board of Governors.
