POLICY 1000P MEMBERSHIP PROCEDURES CORPORATE AND LIFE MEMBERS

In order to ensure that USPC policy, rules, and regulations are created and/or approved by members of USPC of and for the benefit of USPC, Corporate or Life Membership in USPC is necessary for those in policy-making positions and any others as listed in these procedures.

National Youth Board members serving on the Board of Governors and/or on a National Committee (Activities, Instruction, Regional Administration and/or a Board Committee) are granted a Corporate Membership during the duration of their term.

The following positions require current Corporate Membership/Life Membership:

- 1. District Commissioners (DCs) and Joint-District Commissioners.
- 2. Riding Center Program Administrators (CAs) and Assistant Riding Center Program Administrators.
- 3. Regional Supervisors (RSs) and Vice-Regional Supervisors.
- 4. Officers and members of the Board of Governors.
- 5. Members of the Advisory Committee of the Board of Governors.
- 6. Members of the Nominating Committee of the Board of Governors.
- 7. Chairpersons and members of the National Activities, Instruction, and Regional Administration Committees.
- 8. National Examiners (NEs).
- 9. Chief Horse Management Judges (CHMJs).
- 10. Regional Instruction Coordinators (RICs).
- 11. Horse Management Organizers (HMOs).
